To assist us in providing a quality service please note the following important information;

- All children attending this activity **must be registered in advance** of the first session
- **All questions on the Medical/Consent Form must be completed and signed by the parent/guardian before any child takes part**
- **Parents/guardians must ensure that any changes to the information given on the Consent/Medical Form are notified to RYA Scotland Instructors**
- Parents/guardians must ensure that they make their own arrangements for children going to and leaving the session, **please note that RYA Scotland Instructors are not responsible for children out with their session times they should therefore arrive and depart at the appropriate times**
- **It is not the responsibility of RYA Scotland Instructors to ensure that children do not leave the activity venue prior to the end of their session**
- **Children may get wet, as water sports are naturally wet activities**, so please inform the RYA Scotland Instructors if there is an issue with this and ensure your child is prepared; wearing warm, old clothing and soft footwear, with a change of clothing and towel for after the activity, in case required
- **RYA Scotland will not take responsibility for any damaged clothing and/or personal items during the activity**, therefore please ensure your child does not have anything on them that should remain dry and protected, e.g. mobile phone, wallet etc
- **At most venues RYA Scotland Instructors cannot guarantee safety of participants personal belongings as they are in public locations**, so we advise you to discourage your children from bring valuables
- At the beginning of each session RYA Scotland Instructors will provide your child with waterproof trousers and jacket, a helmet and a buoyancy aid, **each child must wear this equipment for the duration on their activity**, unless otherwise advised by their Instructor
- **Please ensure your child has sufficient water, food, clothing, sun screen and medication** (where appropriate) **for the duration of their activity session**
